### **3. Body Paragraph 2**

A topic sentence  
Support this argument with data, supporting evidence, and examples  
How they directly or indirectly relate to your thesis. You can ask online essay [writing service](#) for help.

### **4. Body Paragraph 3**

A topic sentence  
Support the argument with data, facts, and examples  
How it is related to the thesis

### **5. Conclusion**

Summarize all the key points and restate your thesis
